An Online Presentation by Eddy Ruyter

Canadian-based keyboardist / guitarist Eddy Ruyter brings an interactive clinic to the virtual classroom. Focusing on career development, practice, and performance, Ruyter talks about his experiences, and what a day in the life of a musician is like. Ruyter has played with international artists including Shawn Mendes, Khalid, John Mayer, Zac Brown Band, Demi Lovato, the Jonas Brothers, and many others.



For \$176.99* students will receive a 1hr presentation over Zoom, complete with musical performances and a question and answer period. The content of the presentation can be tailored to one of the following options:

Lecture A	This presentation covers initial development, early musical experiences, and career path leading from being a student, to touring internationally. Inspirations, experiences, mistakes, and successes that led to a full time music career are discussed.
Lecture B	This lecture focuses on the technical side of the job. Topics covered include song analysis, repertoire development, sound design, and performance mindset. This is mainly intended for high school students, and students with a strong understanding of music theory.
Lecture C	Lecture C highlights different areas of employment within the music industry. Showing students career options they may not have previously associated with studying music.
